

CALIBRATING THE PEDAL TENSION ON YOUR NEW BUDWAH PEDAL

THANK YOU FOR PURCHASING A NEW BUDDA BUDWAH PEDAL, THE BEST SOUNDING WAH PEDAL EVER MADE! WE HAVE MADE THE PEDAL IN A WAY THAT ALLOWS YOU TO ADJUST THE PEDAL TENSION HOWEVER YOU LIKE IT. SOME USERS LIKE THE PEDAL TO BE VERY SLACK, WHILE OTHERS LIKE TO BE ABLE TO ENGAGE IT AND WALK AWAY WITH IT SOMEWHERE IN THE MIDDLE, PAGEY STYLE! IT'S VERY EASY TO ADJUST YOUR BUDWAH, WHETHER YOU HAVE REVI OR REV2.

REV1 BUDWAHS (WHITE BOX) HAVE A BOLT (SEE BELOW) UNDER THE PEDAL THAT CAN BE TIGHTENED OR LOOSENED TO YOUR DESIRE BY USING A SMM OPEN OR CLOSED BOX WRENCH. REGULAR PLIERS OR VICE GRIPS WOULD WORK AS WELL, BUT THE BOX WRENCH IS THE EASIEST WAY. MAKE SURE AND CHECK THE PEDAL TENSION OFTEN AS YOU ADJUST, IT DOESN'T TAKE A LOT OF TURNS TO MAKE A BIG DIFFERENCE IN THE PEDAL TENSION.



REV2 BUDWAHS WERE DESIGNED TO MAKE THIS ADJUSTMENT A BIT EASIER, SO WE CHANGED THE BOLT TO AN ALLEN HEAD BOLT AND INCLUDED AN ALLEN WRENCH WITH THE PEDAL TO MAKE THE ADJUSTMENTS VERY EASY!
